

Veterinary Assistance- National Grants

Although Roice-Hurst does not have medical funds to assist your pet at this time, we have compiled a list of national grants for veterinary assistance. Roice-Hurst Humane Society is not responsible for the outcome of any involvement with any financial/vet services listed on this referral. Please note that most organizations require documentation when applying such as:

- Proof of financial need such as Social Security Income letter, unemployment letter, a personal letter of hardship, or last paystub if employed.
- Most recent bank statement.
- Diagnosis and estimate of treatment from the attending veterinarian.

To get the best chance of obtaining grant money, applying to more than one organization is not only encouraged but required for some organizations. **Certain procedures, diagnostics, or medications may not be covered.**

Bow Wow Buddies Foundation:

- Does not cover anything stemming from lack of routine care.
- Grants up to \$2500 available.
- Grants are not available for spay or neuter surgeries, dental work, preventative care, ongoing treatments, or end-of-life care.
- Only assists with dogs.

Ginger's Legacy

- Serves the greater Denver/Front Range, Colorado area.
- Pet owner must pay for the initial \$300 of the medical treatment or surgical procedure.
- Qualification process.

Brown Dog Foundation

- Offers pet owners in temporary financial crisis an alternative to euthanasia when their pet faces a treatable but life-threatening condition or illness in order to restore quality of life for pet and owner.

Harley's Hope:

- Pet must have been seen by a vet within the last 18 months.
- Does not cover dentals, or issues stemming from lack of routine care. Will only help with dentals if it's from an autoimmune disease.
- Pets must be spayed/neutered if over 1 year.
- Grants are for no more than \$500.
- Must first apply for Care credit. If you applied and were declined, you will need to submit the declination notice or confirmation number.
- Does not cover diagnostics, x-rays, bloodwork.
- Specific to Colorado.

Hope Mending Hearts:

- Does not cover anything stemming from lack of routine care.
- Have a life-threatening injury or illness that requires urgent and specific treatment.
- \$100-200 grants.
- No office exams or diagnostic tests.
- Applicant must make fundraising efforts.

- Must first apply for care credit.
- Resources for victims of domestic violence and deploying soldiers.

Oscar's Cause

- Will help with dentals.
- Funding will not exceed 75% of the total cost.
- Online application for non-emergency.
- 24 hour emergency help. Fill out online form first. Then call the emergency hotline at 863-325-6508.

Paws4aCure:

- Helps with a variety of procedures including medications and heartworm prevention treatment.
- Does not help with routine dental care.
- \$500 grants.
- Owner required creating their own fundraising page.

- Urgent or life-threatening.
- Does not cover diagnostics, blood work, MRIs, etc.
- **Owner must contribute financially.**

- Helps with issues such as cancer treatment, heart disease. Does not help with basic care such spay/neuter, dentals, etc.
- Email The Pet Fund directly at info@thepetfund.com with a description of the animal's medical needs. Include a phone number where you can be reached with your email as well.
- If the animal's medical needs match the program criteria, they will advise the applicant to complete the application.
