

HOUSE TRAINING YOUR ADULT DOG



When bringing a new dog home, always take the dog out:

- When you arrive home
- First thing in the morning
- Before and after confinement
- After eating
- Right before bedtime
- Any time they signal they need to go

Dogs do not generalize and need you to show them where to go potty.

When house training your dog, NEVER:

- Hit or get physical with the dog
- Push the dog's nose or face into the accident
- Shout or yell at the dog

These methods will only create fear and worsen the issue

Submissive or Excitement Urination

- Ignore the dog.
- Distract the dog
- Build the dogs confidence through praise and training
- Instruct guest to ignore the dog and praise when he sits, etc.

Dogs that are very excited may urinate and dog that are less confident may urinate to show submission

Cleaning up after an accident:

- use an enzyme-based cleaner to remove all odors
