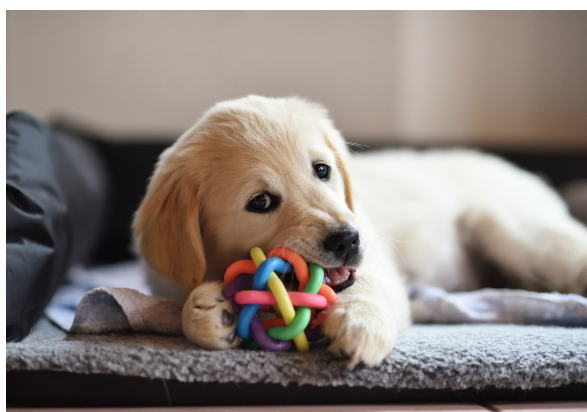


TIPS TO REDUCE BARKING AT HOME



BLOCK THE VIEW BUT NOT THE LIGHT

Out of sight is out of mind. Keeping the view blocked by frosting the windows or light curtains can help reduce barking



REINFORCE ALTERNATE BEHAVIOR

Giving your dog a spot to go helps prevent barking at visitors. Get your dog a bed or crate that is their space they can go to. Reward them with treats and toys when they are in their spot.



QUIET BETWEEN BARKS = CLICK AND TREAT

Keep treats and kibble on hand to use during noisy events (fireworks, thunderstorms, etc). When your dog is quiet and between barks, use a clicker and/or treat to reward them.
